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1. Introduction

4. Enrollment and Registration

Eligibility

The program is open to all students currently enrolled at DT Preparatory Academy.

Registration Process

- 1. Complete the enrollment form available at the school office or on our website.

- 3. Attend a mandatory orientation session with your child before the program starts.

Enrollment Fees:

- We do not accept daycare vouchers
- Registration Fee: \$0 (non-refundable)
- Weekly Fee: \$60 per child up to three children, with a price break beginning with the fourth child.
- Weekly fee is due on the Friday prior to the week of care.

5. Daily Schedule

Before School Care

- 7:00 AM - 7:30 AM: Arrival and free play

- 7:30 AM - 8:00 AM: Breakfast and quiet activities

- 8:00 AM: Dismissal to regular school activities

After School Care

- 2:30 PM - 3:00 PM: Snack time and relaxation

- 3:00 PM - 4:00 PM: Homework help and academic support

- 4:00 PM - 5:00 PM: Enrichment activities (arts, sports, STEM projects)

- 5:00 PM - 6:00 PM: Free play and pick-up

6. Activities and Curriculum

Our enrichment activities are designed to support the academic and personal growth of our students. We offer a diverse range of activities, including:

Activities

Homework Help

Description: Dedicated time and support for students to complete their homework with assistance from qualified staff.

Example: Teachers assist students with math problems, reading comprehension, and science projects.

Arts and Crafts

Description: Creative projects that encourage artistic expression and develop fine motor skills.

Example: Painting, drawing, clay modeling, and holiday-themed crafts.

STEM Activities

Description: Hands-on experiments and projects in science, technology, engineering, and math.

7. Behavioral Expectations and Discipline

Expectations

We expect students to:

- Respect themselves, peers, staff, and the environment.
- Follow instructions and participate positively in all activities.
- Maintain a safe and inclusive environment.

Discipline Policy

We use a positive discipline approach, focusing on teaching and reinforcing appropriate behaviors. Inappropriate behavior will be addressed through the following steps:

- 1. Verbal warning
- 2. Time-out or temporary removal from the activity
- 3. Parent notification
- 4. Meeting with parents and program director
- 5. Suspension or expulsion from the program (in extreme cases)

8. Health and Safety

Health Policies

- Students must have up-to-date immunization records on file.
- If a student becomes ill during the program, parents will be notified immediately.
- Medications will only be administered with a completed Medication Authorization Form.

Safety Procedures

- Students are supervised at all times by qualified staff.
- Emergency drills are conducted regularly.
- All staff are trained in first aid and CPR.

9. Staff Qualifications

Our staff are experienced and dedicated professionals who are committed to providing highquality care and enrichment activities. Each staff member undergoes background checks and receives ongoing training in child development, safety, and curriculum implementation.

10. Parent Communication and Involvement

We believe that open communication between parents and staff is essential for the success of our program. Parents are encouraged to:

- Attend parent meetings and events.
- Volunteer in program activities.
- Communicate regularly with staff about their child's progress and any concerns.

- Fees are due on the Friday prior to the week of care.
- Late payments will incur a \$25 late fee.
